



CoVid Protocols for PSCC:

- Reminder that Masks must be worn prior to entering the PSCC building and remain on throughout the building.
- For those who have not yet provided proof of double vaccination, you will need to bring it before your first game or you can send it to us digitally at pscc@bellnet.ca, abourgeois6@gmail.com or by txt to 705 774 8453. Digital copies will be deleted. We have the app to read the new QR Code provided by the province.
- Hand sanitizer dispensers have been installed in the entry near the key pad, in the spectator lounge (Main Floor), upper lounge area and at each end of the ice surface. Hand sanitizer bottles are also dispersed throughout the building.
- All individuals must wear masks in the facility. You may remove the mask when **sitting at a lounge table when eating or drinking**, or on the ice when curling. Normal curling rules apply, including 2 sweepers, offensive and defensive sweeping in the house.

On the Ice and Equipment:

- The rocks have been set up with Sheets 1 and 3 starting at the far end. Sheets 2 and 4 will start at the glass end.
- Curlers from sheet 1 and 3 will go on the ice first using the north door. Sheets 2 and 4 will use the second door near the locker rooms.
- Masks can only be removed once you are on the ice.
- There is no club equipment available, you must have your own- broom, delivery stick, stabilizer, slider, gripper etc
- There will be no shaking of hands before the game, a team member can bring their own coin on the ice and flip it to determine hammer.
- Rocks need to be sanitized before play. There are wipes available at each end of the rink. One player from each will wipe their set of rock prior to the game. No switching rocks during the game. One person per sheet will keep the score for the game. The wipes and Hand sanitizer is located between sheet 1 and 2 and between sheet 3 and 4 at both ends of the rink.
- Before using equipment on the ice such as, ice cleaning broom, nipper, measuring stick, drill, hacks, please sanitize your hands, and wipe equipment before use. Please sanitize your hands again after use.

Note:

We have 2 hours to play a game. On the first draws of league evening curling, the game is finished at 8:30 PM regardless of where you are in the end, no rock is to be thrown after 8:30 PM. After your game, please place the rocks where they were. The next team will sanitize their own rocks.

Lounge Area:

- Tables in the upper lounge are set such that you can sit 4 people or 8 people as per the guidelines for restaurants. The tables can be moved but you must ensure that there is at least 6 feet between the people sitting at the next table. The tables will be sanitized after each use, and we are asking the last person to leave the table to wipe down the chairs. Sanitizer is provided at each table.
- Protective glass has been installed at the bar. Line up at the bar in the normal manner, maintaining social distancing. You can pay by cash, credit or debit.

- Bar staff are not required to wear a mask when behind the glass partition at the bar and working alone. Bar staff must wear a mask when leaving the area behind the glass partition.
- We are a volunteer driven club so all members will be accountable for sanitizing, protocol awareness and enforcement. It's up to each of us to ensure that we follow these protocols, let's have fun doing it.
